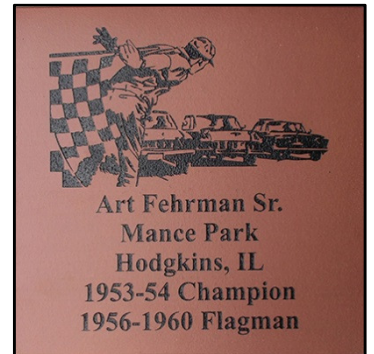


Exhibit B – Lexan/Acrylic Plaque

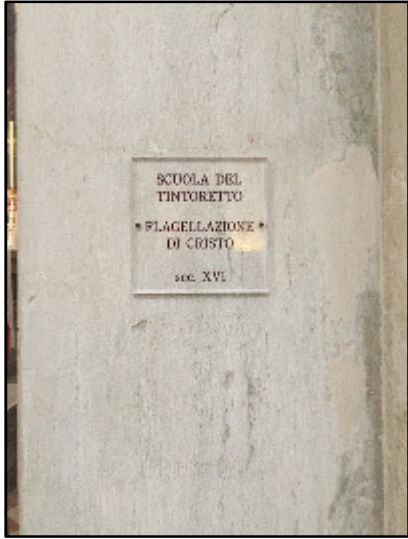


Exhibit C – Ceramic Plaque

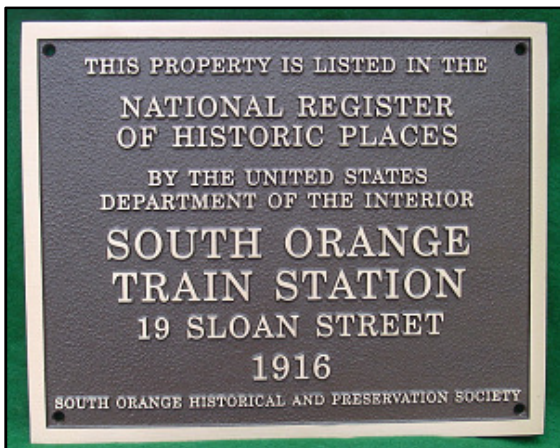


Exhibit E – Honorary/Memorial Street Sign
