Accreditation



The Department is proud to be a nationally accredited agency. National accreditation requires recreation and park agencies be able to demonstrate that the manner in which they operate, meets or exceeds best practice standards, representing elements of effective and efficient recreation and park operations.

First accredited in 2006, the Department went through its second reaccreditation in May 2016. Re-accreditation will be formally conferred by the Commission for Accreditation of Park and Recreation Agencies (CAPRA) at the National Recreation & Park Association (NRPA) conference in October 2016.

The City of Boynton Beach Recreation & Parks Department is one of only 141 agencies in the nation and 22 agencies in the state of Florida to have gone through the process and received national accreditation.
