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WHEREAS, the purpose of this program is to support local fire departments by helping with the acquisition of needed equipment, vehicles and services; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has applied for a grant to be used to replace the department's advanced life support cardiac monitors/defibrillators; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total project cost is \$529,282.00 and the grant is in the amount of \$481,166.00, therefore the City will match the remaining amount of \$48,116.00 from the Fire Department's grant match account; and

WHEREAS, the grant, if awarded, will be used for replacement of our advanced life support equipment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:**

Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. The City Commission approves and authorizes the City to apply for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) from the Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$481,166.00 for the replacement of the Fire Department's advanced life support equipment, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
