Congratulations, the Boynton Beach Boulevard project submitted by the City of Boynton Beach during the 2018 Local Initiatives Program application cycle was incuded on the Palm Beach TPA's FY20-24 Priority Project list, adopted on September 20, 2018. The prioritized federal funding amount is \$2,232,414. Projects are expected to appear on the FDOT Draft Tentative Work Program in December 2018. Formal adoption of the FDOT Work Program and the TPA Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is in June 2019.

Please note, programmed funding in the TIP is intended to produce the outcomes specified in the scope of the project. Minor changes to the scope and cost of the project are acceptable and expected. However, major scoping changes or large increases in cost that impact available funding will require review by TPA staff and FDOT, and require TPA governing board approval. We recommend assuming that any cost increases from the original amount are paid for with local funds.

Once the project is put into the FDOT Work Program, it will be assigned to an FDOT project manager who will be able to assist you throughout the delivery of the project. Thank you for submitting a project that will provide a more safe, efficient, and connected multimodal transportation system.
